Golf Ball Drop 2010 Contest Rules

1. With the purchase of a Golf Ball Drop Raffle Ticket(s), each participant will be entered into the Cayuga/Seneca Community Action Agency (C/SCAA) Golf Ball Drop which will take place on September 12, 2010, at Emerson Park. Participants will receive a ticket with a number; this number will also appear on a corresponding golf ball. Participants may enter more than once, and they do not need to be present to win.
2. C/SCAA reserves the right to modify the Golf Ball Drop due to inclement weather or unexpected events.
3. Prize value will be based on the number of tickets sold. The following prize amounts are based on a minimum of 1,000 tickets sold. First place prize will be \$5,000. Second place will be \$1,000. Third place will be \$500. Fourth place will be \$250. Fifth place will be \$100. Prizes will be prorated if fewer than 1,000 tickets are sold.
4. On September 12, 2010, all sold golf balls will be placed equally distributed, randomly in a large container (or multiple containers if one large one is too heavy to lift). The balls will be dropped from a fire truck ladder above a specially designed green containing a target range.
5. The ball closest to the target is the first prize winner of \$5,000. If there is a dispute regarding which ball is the closest, the winner will be determined by a panel of judges who will conduct a straight-line measurement from the center of the target
6. The final winners will be posted on the C/SCAA web site and winners will be contacted within 48 hours.
7. In the event of inclement weather, the Cayuga/Seneca Community Action Agency Golf Ball Drop will be rescheduled and announced on the Agency website (www.cscaa.com).

8. Only persons 18 years of age or older shall purchase raffle tickets, sell raffle tickets, or assist in the conduct of the raffle drawing/Golf Ball Drop.
9. Eligible entrants completing the entry form and paying the fee of \$15 for one golf ball, \$25 for two golf balls, or \$50 for 5 golf balls will enter.

How to Play:

- All entries must include name, address, and phone number (email address optional) to be eligible and must be delivered to Cayuga/Seneca Community Action Agency, 65 State Street, Auburn, NY, 13021. Balls may be purchased by downloading an entry form and mailing it with a check to the above address or by purchasing one from an authorized agent of Cayuga/Seneca Community Action Agency. All entries must be received with payment by Sunday, September 12, 2010, no later than 2:00 p.m.
- Cayuga/Seneca Community Action Agency is not responsible for tickets that are late, illegible, incomplete, damaged, tampered with, or mutilated.
- By entering this contest, winner consents, without limitation or additional compensation, to the use of their name, voice, photograph/video, likeness and/or entry for advertising and/or trade purposes, except where prohibited by law.
- Certifying officials of the Golf Ball Drop, their spouses, and their dependents are not eligible to participate in the Golf Ball Drop.
- The odds of winning depend upon the number of valid entries received.
- All federal, state and local laws and regulations apply.
- Decisions by the Cayuga/Seneca Community Action Agency panel of certifying officials on all aspects of this event will be final and binding.
- Winners will be notified by phone, mail, and/or e-mail. If a winner cannot be located or fails to claim their prize within thirty (30) days after notification, the prize will be forfeited and returned to Cayuga/Seneca Community Action Agency.

- All entries become the property of Cayuga/Seneca Community Action Agency and will not be returned.
- By participating, each participant releases, discharges, indemnifies and holds harmless Cayuga/Seneca Community Action Agency, TomatoFest, Fleming Fire Department, and Emerson Park, their affiliates, officers, directors, employees, agents, shareholders and representatives, advertising agencies and promotional partners from any and all liability, loss, harm, injury, damage, cost and expense whatsoever arising directly or indirectly from the use of the prize or participation in this drawing.
- All federal, state and local taxes are the sole responsibility of the individual winner. The winner will be required to sign an IRS form W9 or the equivalent for all prizes valued at \$600 or greater, or for any prize as to which Cayuga/Seneca Community Action Agency in its sole discretion, believes is warranted. The winner will be required to execute an Affidavit of Eligibility, and Release indemnification and liability/publicity release within thirty (30) days of notification. In the event of noncompliance within this time period, the prize will be forfeited and returned to Cayuga/Seneca Community Action Agency. Upon forfeiture, no compensation will be given.
